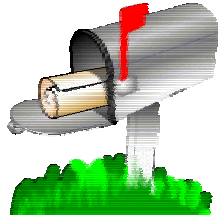
## Homemade Cookies Needed

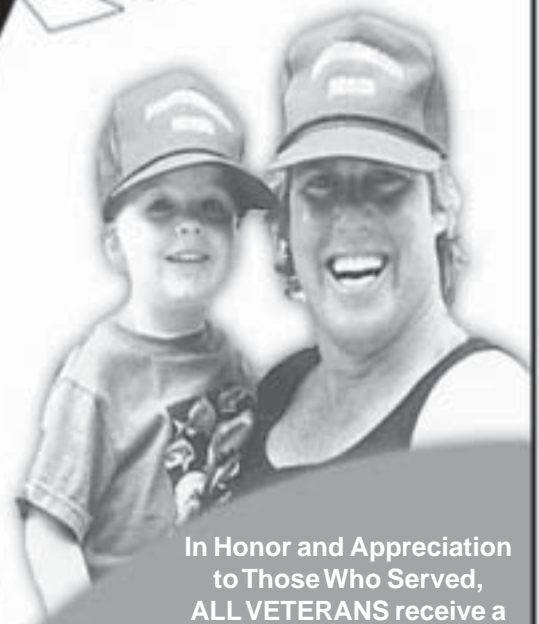
