I would like to welcome our winter visitors and invite them to watch our calendar. We have many new functions over the next three months.

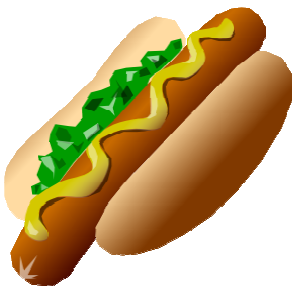
Also, I don't know if it's only me, but I think our Wednesday Big Band has made a big leap in energy and sound lately. Come and enjoy them.

## VFW Youth Patriotic Art Contest



The Young American Creative Patriotic Art Scholarship program is a national competition for college scholarships offered by the Veterans of Foreign Wars Ladies Auxiliary. This contest is open to all students in grades nine through twelve, as well as home

schooled students. Foreign exchange students are not eligible. Students must attend school in the same state as the sponsoring Ladies Auxiliary.

The national first place winner receives a college scholarship for \$10,000, and the winning art will be featured on the cover of VFW Magazine. Second and third place winners will receive scholarships for \$5,000 and \$2,500. Fourth place winner receives \$1,500, and there are \$500 scholarships for fifth through eighth place.

The art must be on paper or canvas. Watercolor, pencil, pastel, charcoal, tempera, crayon, acrylic, pen and ink, or oil may be used. Digital art may be used but must be on paper or canvas. No discs accepted. When submitting digital or computer art it must be original. The art should be no smaller than 8" by 10" but no larger than 18" x 24", not including mat.

A VFW Ladies Auxiliary must sponsor every student.

Please submit your entry to VFW Post 3513 Ladies Auxiliary, care of Michelle McCarville Gladden. March 31, 2011 is the deadline for participating students to submit their entries locally.

The first place winner from each VFW Ladies Auxiliary will be forwarded to the Department chairperson for judging on the state level. Only the winning entry from each state is eligible for the national competition.

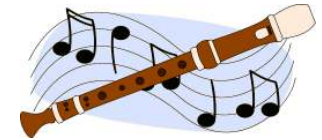
