## VA Services for Caregivers



*Information from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs:* The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) said it is launching the first of a series of new and enhanced services supporting family caregivers of seriously ill and injured veterans. Legislation enacted in 2010 authorized the VA to establish new services to support certain caregivers of eligible Post 9/11 veterans. In addition to the new benefits for eligible veterans who were disabled in the line of duty after Sept. 11, 2001 (post-9/11 veterans), the VA will begin providing enhanced benefits and services to caregivers of veterans of all eras who are already enrolled in VA care, including:

- Access to VA's toll-free Caregiver Support Line: (855) 260-3274,
- Expanded education and training on caring for veterans at home,
- Other support services such as counseling and support groups and referral services, and
- An enhanced website for caregivers.

Each VA medical center has designated caregiver support coordinators who will assist eligible veterans and caregivers in applying for the new benefits. Source: U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs. Go to <http://www.caregiver.va.gov>.
